You're A Ten Out of Ten!

Generate list of combinations that equal ten.

1 or more players Materials:

Paper

Colored pens (each player uses own color)

How to Play:

- 1. Each player writes an equation that equals ten in one color.
- 2. Take turns recording equations on a piece of paper.
- 3. Use 2 numbers in the beginning, then stretch to 3 and 4 numbers that when combined equal ten.
- 4. Use addition and subtraction if you want an added challenge.

Variation

- Play with more than 2 players.
- Use more than one operation.
- List equations that equal 20.
